- How do they stay protected from predators?
- Do they ever go inside?
- Do they take vitamins?

- Does someone clip their nails?
- Does someone brush their hair or groom them?
- Do they brush their teeth?
- Do they have their own bedroom?
- Do they share a bowl with someone else?
- Do they share the pasture with others?
